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

For the quarter ended 30 April 2010

The company conducted a Renounceable Rights Issue during the quarter which closed on 29 March 2010. The result of the Rights Issue was that 525,227,001 new shares and 175,075,463 new options were allotted on 8 April 2010. The total amount of funds raised by the Rights Issue (before costs) was \$2.6m and these funds were received by the company in early April 2010.
